

## CONTRACTOR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS APPENDIX A

## **LIABILITY INSURANCE**

Entegrus requires proof of current liability insurance which must be maintained until the termination of the contract.

- 1. Commercial General Liability Insurance on an occurrence basis for an amount not less than five million (\$5,000,000) dollars covering all aspects of the contract.
- Vehicle insurance, covering liability for bodily injury and property damage caused by any vehicle owned and/or used by the contractor(s) for the work. Such insurance shall have an inclusive limit of two million (\$2,000,000) dollars <u>per</u> <u>occurrence.</u>
- 3. The Contractor shall obtain, provide and maintain a Professional Liability (Errors & Omissions) Insurance Policy for the duration of the Contract. The Policy shall be written **on an occurrence** basis and have a liability limit of not less than two million (\$2,000,000) dollars.

## **GENERAL INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

Please be advised that:

- The per occurrence insurance coverage can be entirely primary insurance or a combination of primary and umbrella insurance if it totals two million (\$2,000,000) dollar.
- The successful bidder is required to name Entegrus on the policy as an additional insured without subrogation.
- Further to this requirement, **the Contractor** shall provide Entegrus with thirty (30) days-notice of cancellation.
- The Policy shall be taken out with an insurance company licensed to carry on the business of insurance in Ontario.
- The Policy shall contain a **cross liability clause** which protects each insured to the same extent as if they were separately insured.
